RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY MODIFYING AN AGENCY RESOLUTION WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN LINE ITEM EXPENDITURES IN THE FY2013 APPROVED BUDGET AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title I of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act"), and Chapter 674 of the 1975 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 922 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, industrial and commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2013-02 of the members of the Agency duly adopted on March 28, 2013 (the "Budget Resolution"), the Agency authorized the Executive Director of the Agency to expend funds of the Agency for certain expense items set forth therein in amounts not to exceed the amounts specified therein with respect to such expense items during the 2013 Fiscal Year of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Agency desires to adjust the amounts allocated to certain expense items set forth in the Budget Resolution and to authorize the Executive Director to make expenditures on behalf of the Agency in accordance with such revised allocations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agency hereby modifies various line items set forth in the Budget Resolution and hereby authorizes the Executive Director to expend the funds of the Agency for such line items in amounts not to exceed the respective revised amounts set forth next to each such line item on Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 2. All other line items and line item amounts set forth in the Budget Resolution shall remain in full force and effect as set forth in the Budget Resolution.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
