RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT TO PROCURE CERTAIN TARGETED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SERVICES IN THE HOMELAND SECURITY SECTOR (CYBER DEFENSE AND INFORMATION ASSURANCE SUB-SECTORS) AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title I of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act"), and Chapter 674 of the 1975 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 922 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, industrial and commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the Agency requires the services of one (1) or more firms ("Firms") to provide certain targeted economic development services in the homeland security sector (cyber defense and information assurance sub-sectors) and perform related services as required by the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Agency issued a Request for Qualifications to Provide Certain Targeted Economic Development Services in the Homeland Security Sector (Cyber Defense and Information Assurance Sub-Sectors) (the "RFQ") seeking statements of qualifications from interested Firms, and the Agency published notice of the issuance of such RFQ on October 13, 2014 in Newsday; and

WHEREAS, the Agency received statements of qualifications from one (1) or more Firms (collectively, the "Statements") expressing interest in providing the services contemplated by the RFQ (collectively, the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with its Charter, the Finance Committee of the Agency reviewed the Statements, determined that interviews of the Firms (each, a "Respondent" and, collectively, the "Respondents") would not be necessary or desirable and found that one (1) of the Respondents meets the minimum requirements set forth in the RFQ and is qualified to provide the Services; and

WHEREAS, the Agency desires to procure the Services as set forth in the Statement from the qualified Respondent, subject to compliance with the Agency's policies and procedures and applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agency hereby ratifies and confirms all actions heretofore taken by the Agency's staff and the Finance Committee in connection with the procurement of the Services pursuant to the RFQ.

Section 2. The Agency hereby determines that (i) the procurement of the Services pursuant to the RFQ constitutes a procurement of professional services involving the application of specialized skills and expertise and a high degree of creativity and, therefore, is not subject to the competitive bidding requirements of the Agency's Statement of Procurement Policy and Procedures, and (ii) the procurement of the Services is in furtherance of the Agency's corporate purposes of promoting job opportunities for the residents of Nassau County.

Section 3. The Agency hereby determines that the proposed action is a Type II Action pursuant to Article 8 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law (including the regulations thereunder, "SEQRA") involving "continuing agency administration" which does not involve "new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment" (6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(20)) and therefore no Findings or determination of significance are required under SEQRA.

Section 4. The Agency hereby accepts the recommendations of the Finance Committee (i) that interviews of the Respondents not be required, and (ii) that the Respondent recommended by the Finance Committee is found to meet the minimum requirements set forth in the RFQ and is qualified to provide the Services. The Agency hereby authorizes the Executive Director to procure the Services from Brian Noone (the "Vendor") at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.

Section 5. The Agency hereby authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and enter into a contract for services or similar agreement with the Vendor with respect to the Services, on such terms and subject to such conditions as the Executive Director may deem advisable or necessary, subject to the terms of this Resolution and the requirements of the RFQ. The Executive Director's execution of any such agreement or contract shall evidence the Agency's approval of the terms thereof.

Section 6. This Resolution shall not preclude the Agency from appointing and engaging other consultants or contractors as determined from time to time by the members of the Agency.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
