RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPOINTING A DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title I of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act"), and Chapter 674 of the 1975 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 922 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, industrial and commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") has from time to time, by resolution of the members of the Agency, appointed certain officers to execute its activities and operations;

WHEREAS, the Agency wishes to appoint a Deputy Executive Director of the Agency and to authorize the Chairman of the Agency to determine the compensation of such officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Having determined that Danielle Oglesby has the experience and qualifications required for the position, the Agency hereby appoints Danielle Oglesby as Deputy Executive Director of the Agency, as of November 1, 2018 with retroactive affect. The Chair of the Agency is hereby authorized to negotiate the compensation and other terms of the employment relationship with the Deputy Executive Director on behalf of the Agency, subject to the Agency's approved budget.

Section 2. This Resolution shall not preclude the Agency from appointing any other officer of the Agency as determined from time to time by the members of the Agency.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
