Resolution No. 2019 - 39

RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AUTHORIZING A PROCUREMENT

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title I of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended, (the "Enabling Act"), and Chapter 674 of the 1975 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 922 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, industrial and commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the Agency wishes to purchase computer tablets, for use by its members, officers and staff in the discharge of their duties to the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Discretionary Funds Policy of the Agency, the purchase of technology that supports the effective discharge of the duties of the members, officers and employees of the Agency, including tablets, is an acceptable expenditure of Agency funds; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Statement of Procurement Policy and Procedures of the Agency, the Chief Executive Officer of the Agency has obtained not less than three (3) price quotations for the purchase of tablets, and his efforts to obtain said price quotations and the results has been documented in reasonable detail, including a recommendation as to which tablet to purchase; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Agency desires to authorize the purchase of said tablets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Agency hereby ratifies and confirms all actions heretofore taken by the staff of the Agency in connection with the procurement of tablets for use by the members, officers and staff in the discharge of their duties to the Agency.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Agency determines that the procurement of tablets pursuant to the requirements of the Discretionary Funds Policy and the Statement of Procurement Policy and Procedures of the Agency is an acceptable expenditure of Agency funds, and that it qualifies as a non-competition bidding procurement.

Section 3. The Agency hereby determines that the proposed action is a Type II Action pursuant to Article 8 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law (including the regulations thereunder, "SEQRA") involving "continuing agency administration" which does not involve "new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment" (6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(26)) and therefore no findings or determination of significance are required under SEQRA.

Section 4. The Agency hereby authorizes and directs its Chief Executive Officer to procure tablets for use by the members, officers and staff of the Agency in the discharge of their duties to the Agency, as recommended in his documented efforts to obtain price quotes and the results.

<u>Section 5</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
