The Village of Farmingdale is struggling to revitalize its downtown, similar to many other villages in Nassau County. The Village Downtown Master Plan proposed a long-range approach to diversify the economy, make the downtown more attractive, increase social amenities, create a connection between the LIRR station and Main Street, and improve the efficiency of transport. The impact on the infrastructure and government-provided services of the proposed Project are insubstantial when compared to the numerous benefits, both tangible and intangible, that would accrue to the community as well as to the County as a whole due to the local and regional economic growth. Therefore, the overall fiscal impact of the proposed Project to the Village of Farmingdale, the Town of Oyster Bay and Nassau County as a whole is expected to be overwhelmingly positive.

- A description of how units will be advertised for sale or rental prior to first occupancy, including whether Applicant will utilize its own website, commercial websites, print media outlets, social media outlets such as Facebook, a sign at the project site, mailings, leaflets/fiyers, brochures, and other forms of advertising;
- A statement that the Applicant will use fair housing logo or phrase "Equal Housing Opportunity" on all advertising described above;
- A statement that the Applicant will distribute written information regarding the availability of affordable units at the project to a list of organizations provided to the Applicant by the Agency, which list may be updated annually;
- Whether the Applicant will conduct the marketing and initial rent-up or sales itself or contract with a third-party;
- 9. A statement that an initial application period with a specific start and end date will be utilized for accepting applications for consideration for the initial rental of the units and that the period will last for at least thirty (30) days after the marketing described in this plan is commenced.
