The Applicant's current lease in Long Island City is scheduled to expire in June 2019. Rents in Long Island City and throughout Queens have drastically increased in the years since the Applicant initially occupied its current premises and a reasonably priced rental in the area has become impossible to find. Therefore, the Applicant has found it necessary to expand its search for a new location for the period after its current rental will expire to additional areas within the tri-state area, which would allow the Applicant to continue to meet the demands of its existing customers in New York and New Jersey and to stay competitive in its industry. Applicant has considered industrial properties in Teterboro NJ and Jersey City NJ which have lower rent and tax costs and which would provide convenient access to construction sites in New Jersey and New York City where a significant part of Applicant's work takes place (see attached). However, with the IDA's assistance a relocation to Hicksville would likewise provide convenient access to New York City job sites and also make Long Island job sites more accessible, and as such, this Project would likewise serve these Applicant's main objectives of lower costs and convenient tri-state access.

Moreover, because Applicant is a union shop, in order to remain competitive in bidding on HVAC construction jobs against non-union competitors in New York and New Jersey, it is necessary that Applicant's real estate and tax costs be minimized which can only be achieved with the IDA's assistance in this Project.

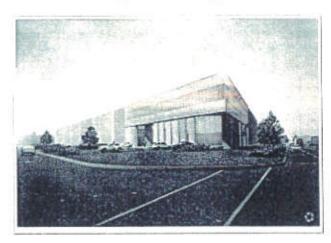
