# RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("THE AGENCY") AUTHORIZING A PAYMENT PURSUANT TO ITS EMPLOYEE BENEFITS HANDBOOK

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title I of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act"), and Chapter 674 of the 1975 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 922 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, industrial and commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting, and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, by resolution, the members of the Agency have adopted an Employee Benefits Handbook, first effective on or as of October 1, 2010 and subsequently amended (hereinafter, the "Employee Benefits Handbook"); and

WHEREAS, the Employee Benefits Handbook provides that, unless terminated for cause, upon termination of service an Officer and Employee of the Agency (as each term is defined or otherwise used in the Employee Benefits Handbook) shall be entitled to receive cash payment for accumulated unused vacation time and sick leave, which payment amount is to be computed pursuant to a specific methodology described within the Employee Benefits Handbook; and

WHEREAS, the Agency's Chief Executive Officer (Harry Coghlan) has tendered his resignation from the Agency, effective May 5, 2022, and he is entitled to payment for accumulated unused vacation time and sick leave;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The members of the Agency authorize a payment to Mr. Coghlan in the sum of \$63,938, for accumulated unused vacation time and sick leave.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Agency hereby determines that the proposed action is a Type II Action pursuant to Article 8 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law (including the regulations thereunder, "SEQRA") involving "continuing agency administration" which does not involve "new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment" (6 NYCRR Section 6.17.5 (c)(26)) and therefore no findings or determination of significance are required under SEQRA.

# Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
