RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO ENGAGE DR. MARTIN CANTOR TO PROVIDE CERTAIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title I of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended, (the "Enabling Act"), and Chapter 674 of the 1975 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 922 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, industrial and commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the Agency issued a Request for Statements of Qualifications to Provide Certain Economic Development Consulting Services (the "RFQ") seeking statements of qualifications from interested Firms, and the Agency published notice of the issuance of such RFQ in *Newsday* and on the New York State Contract Reporter; and

WHEREAS, the Agency received statements of qualifications from one (1) or more Firms (collectively, the "Statements") expressing interest in providing the services contemplated by the RFQ (collectively, the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, an ad hoc committee of the Agency reviewed the Statements, determined that interviews of the respondent Firms would not be necessary or desirable, found that all such Firms meet the minimum requirements set forth in the RFQ and are qualified to provide the Services, and recommended that the Agency establish an approved list of Firms to provide the Services; and

WHEREAS, the Agency established an approved list of Firms to provide the Services pursuant to a resolution adopted by the members of the Agency on November 17, 2022 (the "Approved List Resolution");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Approved List Resolution, the Agency has previously engaged Dr. Martin Cantor (the "Contractor") to provide the Services from time to time with respect to various projects of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its mission and purpose to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, industrial and commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the

job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration, the Agency wishes to engage the Contractor to provide certain economic development consulting services that constitute related professional services within the meaning of the RFQ, and the Contractor wishes to be so engaged.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NASSAU COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agency is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Contractor, pursuant to which the Contractor will prepare a 2022 Annual Economic Impact Report (the "2022 Report") for a fee of Seven Thousand Five Hundred and XX/100 (\$7,500.00) Dollars plus any applicable taxes, as applicable.

Section 2. The Agency hereby determines that the procurement of the 2022 Report is within the scope of the type of services contemplated by the RFQ and constitutes a procurement of professional services involving the application of specialized expertise and a high degree of creativity and, therefore, is not subject to the competitive bidding requirements of the Agency's State of Procurement Policy and Procedures.

Section 3. The Agency hereby determines that the proposed action is a Type II Action pursuant to Article 8 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law (including the regulations thereunder, "SEQRA") involving "continuing agency administration" which does not involve "new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment" (6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(20)) and therefore no findings or determination of significance are required under SEQRA.

Section 4. The Agency hereby authorizes and directs the Executive Director and/or Administrative Director to enter into an agreement with the Contractor to prepare the 2022 Report, on such terms and subject to such conditions as the Executive Director and/or Administrative Director may deem advisable or necessary, subject to the terms of this resolution. The Executive Director's or Administrative Director's execution of any such agreement or contract shall evidence the Agency's approval of the terms thereof.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
