This firm represents TKF Burnside 1000 Woodbury Investment LLC and its affiliates (together, "Applicant") in connection with the enclosed Application for Financial Assistance requested from the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") regarding the acquisition of the office building located at 1000 Woodbury Road, Woodbury, New York (the "Property") and renovation to be made to such building (the "Project"). Please share this Application, and this letter which should be considered part of the Application, with the IDA Chairman and the members of the Agency board.

Project Description

The Applicant is currently in contract to purchase fee title of the Property. The 14.25-acre Property is improved with a 288,000 square foot, four (4) story office building.

This building has historically been a strong performing asset and was once a prominent office building in Nassau County; however, due to the lack of investment in the Property and macro challenges facing the office sector, the vacancy rate at the Property has risen to approximately forty (40%) percent. The Property requires substantial improvements and renovations to reposition this large facility to attract and retain quality office tenants.

With the Agency's assistance, the Applicant is proposing to invest approximately \$8 million (over and above the cost of acquiring the Property) to transform this property into the quality destination for the type of tenants that are instrumental to the local community and economy. Such investments include: (i) critical and strategic capital improvements, including, without limitation, elevator upgrades, roof repairs, building system replacements, common area and amenity improvements and exterior modernization, (ii) the creation of a multi-tenant corridor on the third floor to offer prospective tenants flexible space options, and (iii) substantial and attractive tenant improvement packages to incentivize prospective tenants to enter into long term leases.

When complete, the Facility will be a modern multi-tenant office building with state-of-the-art facilities able to retain and attract quality job creating businesses, which in turn, will provide employment for hundreds of people in Nassau County.

Need for Financial Assistance.

Given the age of the improvements for this property and the challenges facing the office market in general, this investment will require a substantial risk by Applicant. With the high and unpredictable real estate taxes coupled with the high construction costs existing in Nassau County, the proposed investment into this Project would not be feasible at prevailing market rental rates and tax conditions.

In order to make this investment, Applicant requires and is seeking to reduce construction costs through a sales tax abatement and to provide have stability and predictability for the future taxes through a PILOT on this building in order to attract and retain quality tenants.

Without the financial assistance requested, the Applicant cannot justify the proposed level of investment and the property would most likely remain in a marginalized state, outdated resulting in a further loss of existing tenants and the jobs associated with the occupancy. Without the Agency's assistance Applicant would likely not acquire the Property, which would only continue the cycle of stagnation for this significant property. A new owner might operate the building "as is" and attract a lesser quality tenants with reduced investment dollars into improving the property and for tenant installations, compared with the level of tenant and improvements that the updated and renovated Project would bring. This would be a missed opportunity for the Applicant, the County and the community.

Financial Assistance Requested/ Anticipated Benefits.

Applicant requests the following assistance from the Agency:

- 1. a PILOT for a term of twenty (20) years to stabilize the current levels of taxation on the Facility for a period of years and thereafter provide for a reasonable escalation of same going forward for the remainder of the 20-year term;
- 2. a multi-year sales tax exemption for the materials required for the renovation of the building; and
- 3. a mortgage recording tax exemption to the extent that the financing of said acquisition and renovations is secured by a mortgage.

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We greatly appreciate your consideration of the foregoing and we look forward to meeting with the IDA Board to present our application and move this Project forward.

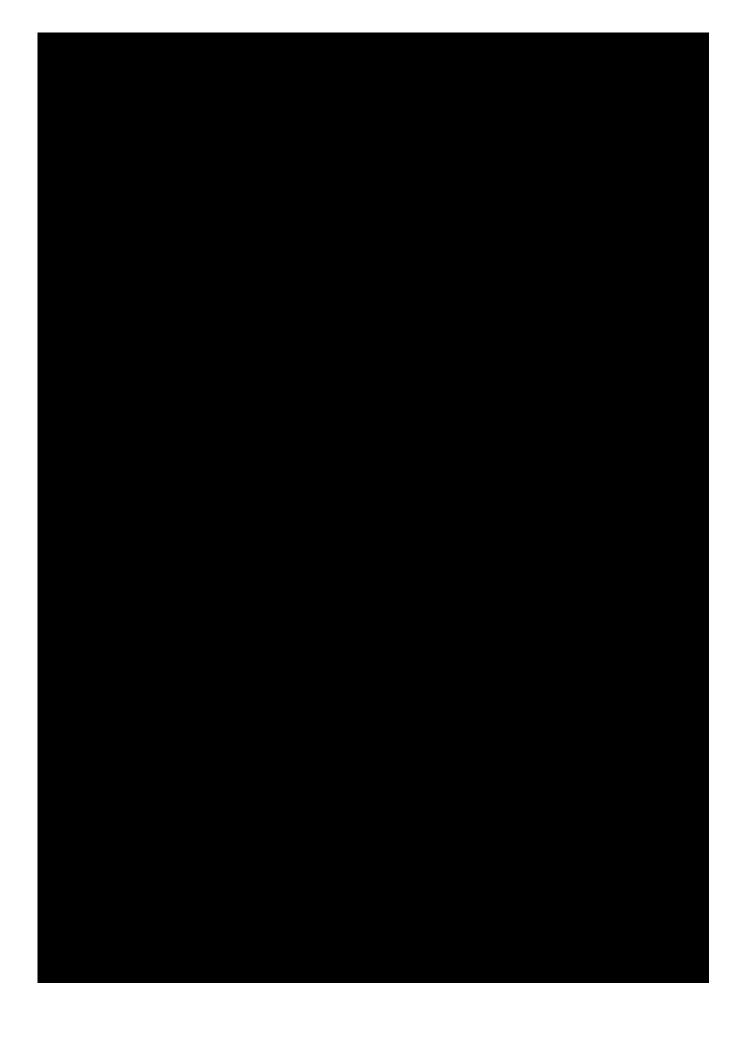

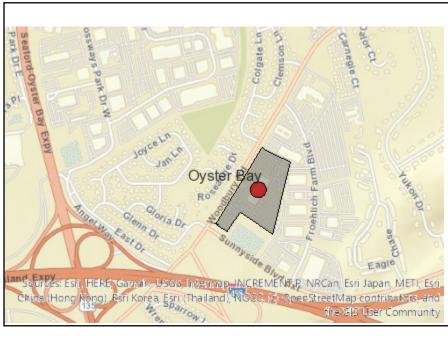

A description of how units will be advertised for sale or rental prior to first occupancy, including whether Applicant will utilize its own website, commercial websites, print media outlets, social media outlets such as Facebook, a sign at the project site, mailings, leaflets/flyers, brochures, and other forms of advertising;
- 6. A statement that the Applicant will use fair housing logo or phrase "Equal Housing Opportunity" on all advertising described above;
- 7. A statement that the Applicant will distribute written information regarding the availability of affordable units at the project to a list of organizations provided to the Applicant by the Agency, which list may be updated annually;
- 8. Whether the Applicant will conduct the marketing and initial rent-up or sales itself or contract with a third-party;
- 9. A statement that an initial application period with a specific start and end date will be utilized for accepting applications for consideration for the initial rental of the units and that the period will last for at least thirty (30) days after the marketing described in this plan is commenced. In addition, a statement that following the initial application period, all the applications submitted during the initial application period will be considered through the use of a lottery and not on a first-come first-served basis, unless the number of applications received during the initial application period is less than the total number of units available for rental.

C. Briefly describe the purpose of the proposed Project, the reasons why the Project is necessary to the Applicant and why the Agency's financial assistance is necessary, and the effect the Project will have on the Applicant's business or operations.

The Property had historically been a strong performing office asset (~90% occupancy over two decades) and a prominent office building in Nassau County. The office market has performed below historical levels in recent years, coupled with current ownership's lack of commitment to make further investments in the Property has resulted in an approximately 40% vacancy rate at the Property. The Property requires substantial improvements to attract and retain quality office tenants who are instrumental to the local community and municipal revenues.

The Applicant is proposing to commit approximately \$8 million for building improvements. The proposed Project will include (a) substantial and attractive tenant improvement packages to incentivize prospective tenants to enter into long-term lease transactions, (b) the creation of a multi-tenant corridor on the third floor to offer prospective tenants flexible space options to meet their demands, and (c) critical and strategic capital improvements including without limitation elevator upgrades, roof repairs, building system replacements, and exterior modernization to further attract and retain quality office tenants.

Predictable and manageable real estate taxes would be essential to the operation and long-term success of the Property.
